- Sharing injection equipment
- Sex without condom use
- Blood to blood contact
- to baby through pregnancy, birth or breast/che Pregnant person NOT on HIV meds can trans

HIV is not transmitted through

- Surfaces (like toilet seats)
- Kissing/sharing drinks
- Food
- Swimming pools
- Casual touch, holding/shaking hands
- Sharing cigarettes
